CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All entries made on this form are correct at the time of entry and subject to these conditions will be honoured at the rally. This entry covers the boat named, no refunds will be made.
2. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry.
3. Third party insurance to an indemnity minimum of £2,000,000 (two million) must be held.
4. A current Bridgewater Canal Licence must be display.
(Boats with a CRT licence are allowed 7 days on the Bridgewater Canal. If you are staying longer please contact Peel Holdings on 0161 629 8432 obtain a short term licence.)
5. Toilets must not be discharged into a waterway.
6. All boats and their components must comply with the conditions in the Moorings Officers instructions.
7. The organisers cannot be held responsible for any damage or loss to persons or property however caused and their ruling on all matters is final.
8. Moorings are at the absolute discretion of the Moorings Officer and may be changed at any time. The Mooring Officer reserves the right to move any boat from the moorings prior to and/or during the rally should the need arise.
9. Any commemorative item or 'goodie bag' will only be issued to those entrants who actually attend the rally.
10. As an aid to the organisers, we will keep the information given overleaf on a computer system but will not divulge the details to any third party and will conform to the Data Protection Act. You may examine your entry by applying to the Rally Secretary during the event.
11. Adults are responsible for their children and pets at all times and in all places. All pets must be kept on a lead when ashore and any fouling disposed of responsibly
